3. Ceremonies, Proclamations, Presentations

3a. <u>12-117</u> Greater Portland, Inc. Presentation - Eric Underwood, Economic Development Manager

Eric Underwood, Economic Development Manager, said the Clty had joined a regional economic development group called Greater Portland, Inc. He explained the composition of the group and what was discussed in the meetings. He then introduced Maggie Finnerty and Colin Sears of Greater Portland, Inc. who would give a presentation on the group.

Mr. Sears said the focus of the group was to help businesses expand and relocate to the greater Portland area and job creation. He and Ms. Finnerty explained the new economic realities, economic development work plan, business development project pipeline, marketing and branding, and export initiative strategies.

There was discussion regarding what was included in advanced manufacturing.

4. Citizen Comments

William Gifford, resident of Oregon City, spoke as the secretary of the CIC. He gave thanks to High Cliff for allowing the Tower Vista Neighborhood Association to use the fireplace room for their association meeting. He also thanked John Lewis, Public

Works Director, for his presentation on the water rate study. The Chamber and CIC were working together to hold a candidates forum on October 2.

6a. 12-112 Second Reading of Ordinance No. 12-1006, Amending Title 12.04 of the Oregon City Municipal Code for Pavement Cut Restoration Standards

6c. 12-108 OPRD Local Government Grant Agreement-Rivercrest Park Restroom

Scott Archer, Community Services Director, stated this was a grant agreement from the State's Parks and Recreation Department for the Rivercrest Park restroom project. The City was awarded \$150,000 with an equal City match of \$150,000. He explained the project and funding source. The design concept would be similar to what had been done at Wesley Lynn Park.

8. Communications

8a. City Manager

David Frasher, City Manager, stated the Singer Falls lighting event was scheduled for September 26 following the last downtown Farmers Market. Mayor Neeley, Commissioners Pauli and Roth, and Mr. Frasher would be attending the League of Oregon Cities Conference September 27-29.

Maureen Cole, Library Director, passed out a Save the Date card for the 100th anniversary of the Carnegie building.

Mr. Frasher reported on the high speed rail project. Mr. Lewis would be the City's representative on the Passenger Rail Forum and citizens could attend an open house and provide comments on the website. The deadline for comments was October 31. He announced John Lewis was hired as the new Public Works Director.

Wyatt Parno, Finance Director, gave an update on his first three months with the City. He had done a Finance Department assessment focused on financial reporting, financial operations, and customer service and communication and explained the changes he was proposing in the Finance Department.

Mr. Frasher said the Friday Highlights would be forwarded to the Commission candidates throughout the duration of the election.

8b. Mayor

Mayor Neeley reported on the Main Street project completion celebration, tour of a Main Street project at St. Johns, and League of Oregon Cities legislative priorities.

Mayoral appointment of Sha Spady to the Natural Resources
Committee for the term September 19, 2012 - December 31, 2012.

Mayor Neeley announced a vacancy on the Planning Commission and openings at the end of the year for the Budget Committee, Oregon City Improvement Trust, Library Board, Metro Enhancement Committee, Natural Resources Committee, Parks and Recreation Advisory Committee, Planning Commission, Transportation Advisory Committee, and Urban Renewal Commission.

Mayor Neeley appointed Sha Spady to the Natural Resources Committee for the term September 19, 2012 - December 31, 2012.

8c. Commission

Commissioner Roth asked about suspicious activities at Waterboard Park. Mr. Archer would look into it.

Commissioner Roth also asked for an update on the elevator lighting. Mr. Lewis said

the City accepted the funding and plans were moving forward.

Commissioner Roth would be the alternate voting delegate for the League of Oregon Cities Conference.
