Meeting called to order at 7:00.

John Fetzer, OCPD Traffic Division, discussed his role with the police department as a dedicated traffic enforcement officer. He passed out his business card and encouraged anyone experiencing traffic related issues to contact him directly.

Mike Day, South End OCPD officer, gave an overview of the 2016 crime statistics in our neighborhood.

Kelly Reid, OC Planning Department, gave an update of proposed developments in the city as well as a comprehensive update of the Riverwalk.

John Williams then led a discussion of the challenges facing Oregon City as it relates to the new rules for annexation. The Oregon City Charter requires a vote of the people in order to annex properties into the city. The state of Oregon recently passed a law that appears to negate that requirement, but it is being challenged by several cities across the state.

As a result of the discussion, Joyce Clark moved, seconded by Gary Fergus, that the South End Neighborhood Association formally recommends that the "Oregon City Commission continue to follow the voter approved charter requirement and continue to submit to the voters any future annexation to the city."

The motion was passed unanimously by the members present.
