##### Joint Work Session between the Planning Commission and Natural Resources Committee

*Pete Walter, Planner, discussed the bylaws and role of the Natural Resources Committee (NRC) including giving comments and advice on Planning Commission decisions. He reviewed the NRC's accomplishments and work plan priorities.*

*There was discussion regarding sending to the NRC applications that would make changes to the Natural Resources Overlay District so the NRC could review them and make recommendations. It was suggested that large changes should be required to come to the NRC, while smaller changes should be recommended to come to the NRC.*

*There was further discussion regarding tree removals before applications were submitted, curving sidewalks and streets around trees to save the trees, how wetlands were treated that were outside of the NROD, changing the requirements for the Heritage Tree program to make it less onerous, mitigation for tree removal, and incentivizing tree protection.*

*NRC Chair Neeley said the biggest concerns were the NROD changes and Heritage Tree issues.*

*The NRC members left the meeting.*

##### Overview of How the Public May Learn About and Stay Involved with Land Use Decisions

*Dilliana Vassileva, Planner, gave an overview of the public noticing that the Planning Department did for different levels of land use proposals and the opportunities the*
