Thank you Damon. I appreciate the MNA considering this situation.

These facilities are designed to be on a 4 inch diameter steel post. I suppose we could paint the posts black for that "close to historic look" and to match the other signal poles.

Timing with the Washington signal is not planned given that this system is not interconnected. The cost for interconnect and controller changes was not something we had planned. Interconnection while possible would be high. But again, pedestrian crossings at this location will impact the Washington signal if traffic is high, whether or not a rapid flashing pedestrian signal exists or not.

Christina I have noted that the HRB meets on May 28th. I'll get something to you for this meeting but what is the deadline?

Hi John,

This is a heads-up for you. The MNA voted to support the crossing without HRB review..IF... the statues support it. Denyse will review the Historic and 7th street corridor overlays to confirm. We do have one "demand" and one request. The demand is that the poles look as close to the historic look as possible, and the request is that the light be timed with the Washington St light so that they don't create a gridlock situation.

The Steering Committee will be sending you a letter to this effect ASAP!
