

Oregon City School District Bond Timeline

Nov. 2017

1 Year Out

Bond Development Task Force presents plan to the School Board that includes scope of work and financial package.

10 Months Out

- Develop multi-channel listening process to solicit feedback from community
- Engage information campaign with core constituencies
- Start legal process on the measure

6 Months Out

- Expand outreach to community
- Invest in social media ads
- Send out mailers
- Share videos
- Engage local media

4 Months Out

- Continue outreach
- Additional mailers
- Circle back to core constituencies
- Plan and launch back to school bond educational campaign

2 Months Out

- Letters to the editor
- School based signage posted
- Additional social media push
- Presentation to key community groups

4 Weeks Out

- Testimonials on social media
- Continue sharing presentations to key community groups

2 Weeks Out

- Direct mail to all OC residents
- Paid digital media
