We have reviewed the submitted bid from the apparent low bid received for the above referenced project. A total of five (5) bids were received ranging from \$723,544.00 to \$847,210.00. Based on the submitted bid documents, the apparent low bidder appears to be responsible and responsive.

The lowest responsive and responsible bid was submitted by Elting Northwest Inc. from Clackamas, OR in the amount of Seven Hundred Twenty-Three Thousand Five Hundred Forty-Four Dollars and Zero Cents (\$723,544.00).

We have reviewed Elting NW's bid bond and have checked their current status relative to state licensing and found it to be in order along with verifying that the contractor is not listed on the debarred contractors list. We also contacted the references provided in their bid and received no comments that would warrant further action.
