4a. 14-109 Purchase and Sale Agreement and Preliminary Title Report for the Cove Project

Eric Underwood, Economic Development Manager, said these were precondition items and were under deadline. They had to be turned in within 30 days of the effective date of the DDA, which was done. The Commission had until March 11 to approve it. The documents were vetted through the Urban Renewal attorney who deemed them complete with no issues. This was only for the purchase of the private parcel. He recommended approval.
