1. Brief project description:

The project components were: 1) created barbeque picnic areas including new picnic tables and a grill at Clackamas Heights and Oregon City View Manor Public Housing Developments; 2) installing a new neighborhood sign at Oregon City View Manor; 3) implementing fall community harvest festival picnics at Oregon City View Manor and Clackamas Heights; 4) implementing two yards contests; and implementing a Seed to Supper Nutrition workshop.

2. Description of project accomplishments:

There was outstanding participation at the events including the harvest festival picnics, bulb give-away, yard contests and the Seed to Supper classes; the neighborhoods have a fresh clean appearance; and new picnic tables and a new sign were assembled and placed in the neighborhood.


