A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF OREGON CITY TO APPLY FOR A LOCAL GOVERNMENT GRANT FROM THE OREGON PARKS AND RECREATION DEPARTMENT FOR DEVELOPMENT OF GLEN OAK PARK AND AUTHORITY TO THE COMMUNITY SERVICES DIRECTOR TO SIGN THE DELEGATING APPLICATION

WHEREAS, the Oregon Parks and Recreation Department is accepting applications for the Local Government Grant Program; and

WHEREAS, the City of Oregon City desires to participate in this grant program to the greatest extent possible as a means of providing needed park and recreation acquisitions, improvements and enhancements; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission_have identified park improvements at Filbert Run Park as a high priority need in the City of Oregon City; and

WHEREAS, the citizens of Oregon City have identified open turf areas, a picnic shelter, trails, a nature play area and landscape improvements as a high priority through the Park Master Plan process; and
