## **RESOLUTION NO. 18-13**

## A RESOLUTION SUSPENDING OREGON CITY MUNICIPAL CODE CHAPTER 2.30.060 CITIZEN INVOLVEMENT COMMITTEE GRIEVANCES WHILE BEING REVIEWED AND REVISED

WHEREAS, Oregon City Municipal Code (OCMC) 2.30.060 creates a process for the Citizen Involvement Committee (CIC) to review grievances of members, neighborhood associations, or any person considering themselves adversely affected by the CIC; and

**WHEREAS,** Goal 4 of the 2017-2019 adopted CIC Goals and Work Plan support analyzing OCMC 2.30.060, including the Code and review process to make a recommendation to the City Commission on how it could be improved; and

WHEREAS, on April 2, 2018, the CIC voted to request the City Commission suspend the Grievance process set forth in OCMC 2.30.060 to a date certain while the CIC is reviewing potential revisions to the Grievance Code and processes; and

WHEREAS, The CIC will meet with the City Commission at a future noticed Work Session to review suggested revisions to the Grievance Code and process; and

**WHEREAS,** any changes to OCMC 2.30.060 Grievance will be adopted by the City Commission at a noticed City Commission meeting.

## NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF OREGON CITY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

**Section 1.** The Oregon City Commission, by this resolution, suspends the Grievance process set forth in OCMC 2.30.060 to a date certain of December 31, 2018 unless revisions to the subject Code are adopted by the City Commission sooner.

**Section 2.** This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption by the City Commission.
