- **Whereas**, for more than a century, the bicycle has been an important part of the lives of most Americans; and
- **Whereas**, today, millions of Americans engage in bicycling as an environmentally sound form of transportation, an excellent form of fitness, and quality family recreation; and
- **Whereas**, cycling is a community asset and source of identification; serves as attraction and location factor for new residents and businesses; provides a key quality of life amenity; and draws tourism spending; and
- **Whereas**, the education of bicyclists and motorist as to the proper and safe operation of bicycles is important to ensure the safety and comfort of all users; and
- **Whereas**, bicycle commuting benefits both employees and employers through better employee health and fitness; reduced commuting and parking congestion; and
- **Whereas**, the National Household Travel Survey showed that the number of trips made by bicycles in the U.S. more than doubled from 1.7 billion in 2001, to 4 billion in 2009, and even more today; and
- **Bhereas**, the League of American Bicyclists has established May as National Bicycle Month, and bicycling is celebrated throughout the country during May; and
- Phereas, in June 2018, 20-year resident of Oregon City, Kraig Pauli age 51, finished 5th place in the annual unsupported bicycle race called the Trans AM. The race covered 4200 miles through 10 states from Astoria, Oregon to Yorktown, Virginia. Kraig was 3rd in bicycles to finish in 18 days, 14 hours and 46 minutes an average 226 miles a day; and
- **Whereas**, the City of Oregon City would like to honor and congratulate Kraig Pauli for his dedication, perseverance, and excellent job in this race, along with encouraging other members of the community to enjoy bike riding for all of the health and environmental benefits.
