Our office recently received a request to review an application for the project referenced above. In checking our statewide archaeological database, it appears that there have been no previous archaeological surveys completed within the proposed project area, but archaeological sites are known to exist in the surrounding area. The project area is located on a landform generally perceived to have a high probability for possessing archaeological sites and buried human remains. In the absence of sufficient knowledge to pinpoint the exact location of cultural resources within your proposed project area, and due to the high likelihood of significant archaeological sites being present, we suggest that the applicant contact a professional archaeologist to conduct a archaeological survey of the project area.
