- -we will also be getting some new security cameras; they will be placed on the corner of the building outside of children's, looking towards the Carnegie, to get a better view of what transpires on the 7th Street side of the building;

Staff:

- -on October 8, which is staff training day, the Police Department will be training us on Code Adam (missing child) and Active Shooter. Since that is really intense, during the other part of the day, we are considering touring the Ermatinger House and other area historical spots;
- -Gina and Denise will be starting the Next Leaders Program with the Chamber of Commerce -we recently hired about 8 new on-calls.

Summer Reading Wrap-up:

Youth:

- 1,757 youth signed up this year (371 wiggle worms, 1118 kids, 268 teens)
- Percentages for age/grade ranges are almost exactly the same as last year
- Registration increased 10% from last year
- Between participation increase and population decrease, 1 in 5 youth in Oregon City registered for SRP this year (up from 1 in 10 in 2016)
- Beavercreek Elementary registration increased by 72% after our June 1 assembly visits
