NOTICE OF NIGHTTIME CONSTRUCTION AND NOISE

Dear Neighbor,

As you were recently notified, the South Fork Water Board is constructing a new 42-inch transmission main within Cleveland Street between Hunter Avenue and Hiram Avenue. The project is approaching an important stage when the contractor will be making the final connection to the existing 30-inch transmission main at the intersection of Cleveland Street and Hiram Avenue.

Due to the sensitive nature of this work, construction of this connection will require nighttime work. Work associated with this connection is scheduled to begin during the evening of Wednesday,

November 14th and may extend until Friday, November 16th. The contractor, Emery and Sons, will make special efforts to reduce impacts, but nighttime construction often includes bright lights, vibration, and noise from vehicle engines, generators, and truck back-up alarms.

Thank you for your patience and understanding as the South Fork Water Board, the City of Oregon City, and the contractor work to complete these construction activities as guickly as possible while minimizing the associated noise and water service disruptions.

SOUTH FORK WATER BOARD ASKS FOR RESTRICTED WATER USE NOV. 14-16

SFWB, the water provider for the City of Oregon City, and portions of the Clackamas River Water District, is asking customers to restrict outdoor irrigation. Agencies are discouraging all nonessential uses of domestic water, including recreation, residential car washing, remodeling, reconstruction, and cleaning uses, unless absolutely necessary for public health or safety.

All agencies appreciate the support and cooperation of the community as SFWB repairs a low volume, low pressure leak in a primary transmission pipeline and also connects a newly constructed 42-inch primary transmission pipeline.

Reducing the amount of water each household uses November 14 – 16 will help keep reservoirs full during the project. This request is out of an abundance of caution for this project.
