## **RESOLUTION NO. 19-01**

## A RESOLUTION TO ADOPT THE 2019-2024 OREGON CITY PUBLIC LIBRARY STRATEGIC PLAN

WHEREAS, in September 2017 staff at Oregon City Public Library began working with a consultant from the State Library of Oregon to create a new strategic plan as the existing strategic plan was ending in 2018; and

**WHEREAS**, through a series of in-library and online opportunities, library patrons were asked what was important to them about Oregon City; and

**WHEREAS,** facilitated staff meetings were held which were completely focused on strategic planning and the future of the library; and

WHEREAS, a group of people who represented library stakeholder groups was gathered and in two meetings, each lasting several hours, the future role of the library in the community was discussed; and

**WHEREAS,** findings from all the above interactions were reviewed multiple times with staff and the Library Board; and

WHEREAS, each group contributed to the selection of strategic focuses and to a specific portion of the Vision (staff), Mission (stakeholders), Core Values and Guiding Principles (Library Board); and

**WHEREAS,** all this information was compiled into a pleasing, easy to read, and extremely usable document which will help direct and define the direction of the Oregon City Public Library operations, projects, staff, and resources for the next several years; and

. **WHEREAS**, this is a living document, which will be reviewed annually and revised no later than 2024.

## NOW, THEREFORE, OREGON CITY RESOLVES:

**Section 1.** The City Commission to adopt the 2019 – 2024 Oregon City Library Strategic Plan and thanks all the many parties who contributed to its creation.

**Section 2.** This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption by the City Commission.
