- Think creatively outside the box
- Recognize that the Mayor is in charge of the timing at a meeting
- No surprises
- Listen
- Don't form opinions based on history, remain open to new strategies
- Listen to all viewpoints with an open mind
- Do not make final decisions prior to meetings
- Do not avoid members of the public whom you don't agree with
- Listen to the public; don't react; bring details to staff
- Treat all with the same respect
- No interruptions
- Promote constructive relationships; get to the bottom of it privately
- Ask, "What do you think?"
- Tell the whole story about an issue
- Do not use your position as a member of the Commission to try to get something done outside your role as a Commissioner
- Do not say at a Commission meeting, "I think, or I believe, that something negative occurred absent evidence."
