**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF OREGON CITY TO APPLY FOR A LOCAL GOVERNMENT GRANT FROM THE OREGON PARKS AND RECREATION DEPARTMENT FOR DEVELOPMENT OF GLEN OAK PARK AND AUTHORITY TO THE COMMUNITY SERVICES DIRECTOR TO SIGN THE DELEGATING APPLICATION**

**WHEREAS**, the Oregon Parks and Recreation Department is accepting applications for the Local Government Grant Program; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Oregon City, through it's Parks and Recreation Department, desires to participate in this grant program to the greatest extent possible as a means of providing needed park and recreation acquisitions, improvements and enhancements; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Commission have identified park improvements at Filbert Run Park as a high priority need in the City of Oregon City; and

**WHEREAS**, the citizens of Oregon City have identified open turf areas, a picnic shelter, trails, a nature play area and landscape improvements as a high priority through the Park Master Plan process; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Oregon City has available local matching funds to fulfill its share of obligation related to this grant application should the grant funds be awarded; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Oregon City will provide adequate funding for on-going operations and maintenance of this park and recreation facility should the grant funds be awarded.

**NOW, THEREFORE, OREGON CITY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1:** The City Commission demonstrates its support for the submittal of a grant application to the Oregon Park and Recreation Department for development of Filbert Run Park.

**Section 2:** This Resolution shall be effective following its adoption by the City Commission.
