 - Contract with Multiphase Electric to complete work- FBVCH to work with City staff on permitting & sign-off June to July 31, 2019- (depending on scheduling with contractor)
- Determine needed exterior and interior improvements
 - -List priority improvements and determine options for funding
 - -Partner with local contractors to determine minimal funding required for desired outcomes-November 1, 2019
- File an application to designate the building as a local landmark in the Oregon City inventory of Historic Resources
 - -Coordinate with city staff on application May June 2019

- Pursue National Register of Historic Places listing with the State Historic Preservation Office (SHPO)
