

**RESOLUTION NO. 19-28**

---

**A RESOLUTION ADJUSTING ALARM SYSTEM USER PERMIT FEES TO BECOME MORE  
CONSISTENT WITHIN THE REGION**

**WHEREAS**, the Oregon City Police Department currently oversees 1,546 alarm system user permits and is dispatched to an average of 76 alarm activations per month; and

**WHEREAS**, Oregon City Municipal Code (OCMC) 5.08.060(D) establishes the setting of alarm system user permit fees by City Commission resolution; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Oregon City adopted Resolution No. 15-02 establishing the schedule of fees and assessments for alarm system user permits; and

**WHEREAS**, Resolution No. 19-28 shall replace Resolution No. 19-07; and

**WHEREAS**, the City desires to adjust the alarm system user permit fees to become more consistent with the permit fee scale within the region of surrounding who have also contracted with PMAM Corporation, an alarm system management company.

**NOW THEREFORE, THE CITY OF OREGON CITY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1.** The attached Fee and Fine Schedule for Alarm System User Permits (Exhibit A) is hereby adopted.

**Section 2.** This resolution will take effect July 3, 2019 and the rates charged for alarm system user fees and penalty assessments shall be adjusted to account for inflation in an amount not to exceed 3 percent, so long as the primary objective of adherence with the alarm system program is not adversely impacted. Minor annual adjustments may be waived and accumulated for rounding or reasonable administration.
