

RESOLUTION NO. 19-17

**A RESOLUTION UPDATING THE POLICY FOR CROSS STREET BANNERS AND
BANNERS ON STREET LIGHT POLES**

WHEREAS, the City has adopted Resolution 15-09, implementing the Oregon City Banner Policy regarding cross street banners and banners on street light poles; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to update the existing Oregon City Banner Policy to extend the maximum amount of time a banner can remain in place; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to eliminate current zones from the Banner Policy, making it more convenient for citizens to place banners in multiple areas of the City; and

WHEREAS, Exhibit 1 includes the Policy for Cross Street Banners and Banners on Street Light Poles.

NOW, THEREFORE, OREGON CITY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

The City Commission of Oregon City hereby approves and amends the Oregon City Banner Policy as set forth in Exhibit "1," as the Policy for Cross Street Banners and Banners on Street Light Poles.

Section 1. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption by the City Commission.
