

Synopsis of Changes in the City of Oregon City Addendum to the Clackamas County Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan

The main changes include the following:

- Actions (this information is also on p. 41-42 of the addendum; additional information can be found in the “2018 status” section of the action item form):
 - Completed – MH #8 – Oregon City Emergency Operations Plan
 - Removed – MH #4, MH #5, ST-FL #2, ST-LS #3, WF #1 – action items removed since they are part of the implementation plan
 - New – WF #3 – Wildfire Action #3 Promote fire-resistant strategies and the use of non-combustible roofing materials in high fire-hazard areas
- Community Asset information was updated as applicable (pp. 15-19)
- Hazard Characteristics (probability/vulnerability ratings)
 - Drought: probability increased; vulnerability decreased
 - Earthquake: hazard split into Cascadia subduction zone and crustal
 - Cascadia: probability did not change, vulnerability increased
 - Crustal: probability decreased, vulnerability increased
 - New earthquake impact data added from DOGAMI report (O-08-02; pp. 26-27)
 - Flood: probability/vulnerability did not change. Updated NFIP information.
 - Landslide: probability did not change, vulnerability increased
 - Added new data from DOGAMI report (O-16-02; p. 31)
 - Severe weather:
 - Extreme heat: probability increased, vulnerability did not change
 - Windstorm: probability/vulnerability did not change
 - Winter storm (snow/ice): probability decreased, vulnerability did not change
 - Volcanic event: probability/vulnerability did not change
 - Wildfire: probability did not change, vulnerability increased
