Scott Watson, resident of Lake Oswego, provided an overview regarding the rental market, profile, and pricing estimates. Lloyd Hill, resident of West Linn and part of Hill Architects, provided details regarding the Phase II proposal including the challenges of the site, public improvements and public access, parking, the various buildings included and the amenities, along with the

development in five phases.

Phase 3: Cove Waterfront Residences (Building D) Phase 4: Water Quality/Mitigation

Plan

Phase 5: Non-Motorized Marina/Swim Dock & Beaches

Steve Shapiro, Shapiro Didway Landscape Architects in Portland, OR, provided an overview of the landscaping and habitat plans for the site.

Rob Affleck, resident of Camas, WA, provided an overview of the finances for the project saying it would be a HUD insured loan and estimated costs would be \$90 million.

Steve Deacon, CEO Deacon Construction resident of Portland, OR, provided an overview of his company's history and how pleased they are to be the General Contractor and Co-Developer for the Cove Phase II Project.

Matthew Riegg, resident of Canby and program administrator for Rivers of Life Center, speaking on behalf of Jerry Herrmann, his boss. They submitted and read a letter for the record in support of the Cove project.
