Process for Appointing Commission Position No. 2

**RECOMMENDED ACTION (Motion):**

Staff recommends the City Commission discuss the process and length of time for accepting applications for the vacancy on the City Commission.

**BACKGROUND:**

Effective January 18, 2019, Commissioner Nancy Ide resigned from position number 2 on the City Commission. There are two years remaining on the term for this position. The City Charter Chapter VII - Vacancies in Office, Section 32 - Filling of Vacancies, states in part:

*Vacant elective offices in the City shall be filled by appointment. A majority vote of the Commission shall be required to validate the appointment. The appointee's term of office shall begin immediately upon his/her appointment and shall continue until the next general election and until a successor is duly elected and qualified to complete the unexpired or new term of office as applicable.*

When the City has had Commission vacancies in the past, this is the process that has been used to fill that position.

February 4th - March 4th	Advertisement of vacancy
March 4th, 5:00 p.m.	Deadline to submit application materials
March 14th	Interview applicants and discussion (Special City Commission meeting held)
March 20th	Vote on appointment
April 3rd	Oath of Office for newly appointed Commissioner
