Resolution No. 19-20, Declaring Oregon City's Election to Receive State Revenues

## RECOMMENDED ACTION (Motion):

Move to adopt Resolution No. 19-20, A Resolution Declaring Oregon City's Election to Receive State Revenues.

#### **BACKGROUND:**

Oregon City is eligible to receive approximately \$405,000 for 2019/20 and \$415,000 for 2020/21 in state revenue sharing funds (liquor tax revenue). In order to receive the revenue, the City must have levied property taxes in the preceding year, and:

- 1. Pass a resolution approving participation in the program and file a copy of that resolution with the State prior to July 31 each year,
- Hold the following hearings on the use of state revenue sharing funds: a) a public hearing before the Budget Committee to discuss possible uses of the funds and b) a public hearing before the City Commission on the proposed uses of the funds in relation to the entire budget, and
- 3. Certify to the Oregon Department of Administrative Services no later than July 31 of each year.
