### Library Board Interviews

#### **RECOMMENDED ACTION (Motion):**

Interview candidates and make recommendation to the mayor

#### **BACKGROUND:**

The following people have applied for two open positions on the Library Board, one position for 'in-city', one position for 'out of city':

##### In city:

Douglas DeHart - City Resident  
Scott Edwards - Reapplying - City Resident  
Michael Larrabee - City Resident  
Rosa Walker - City Resident

##### Out of city:

David Goldberg - Non-Resident  
Suzanne Jefferson - Reapplying - Non-Resident position

The candidates' applications are attached. Pursuant to City Recorder's guidelines, each candidate will be interviewed at the regular monthly meeting of the Library Board on November, 13, 2019.
